Registration Fee

\$175 per student

Reduced to \$125 per student with registration on or before February 12.

Non-Refundable and does not apply to the total tuition cost.

The registration fee will be assessed through FACTS and processed with the online enrollment.

Payment Options

- Pay in Full (July 31st)
- Two payments (July 31st and December 31st)
- Ten monthly payments (August-May) available on 5th, 20th or 25th.

Administrative processing fee is \$10 per payment for two payments and \$5 per month for the ten monthly plan.

The school year runs from August 18 to May 27 and follows the St. John School Academic Calendar.
